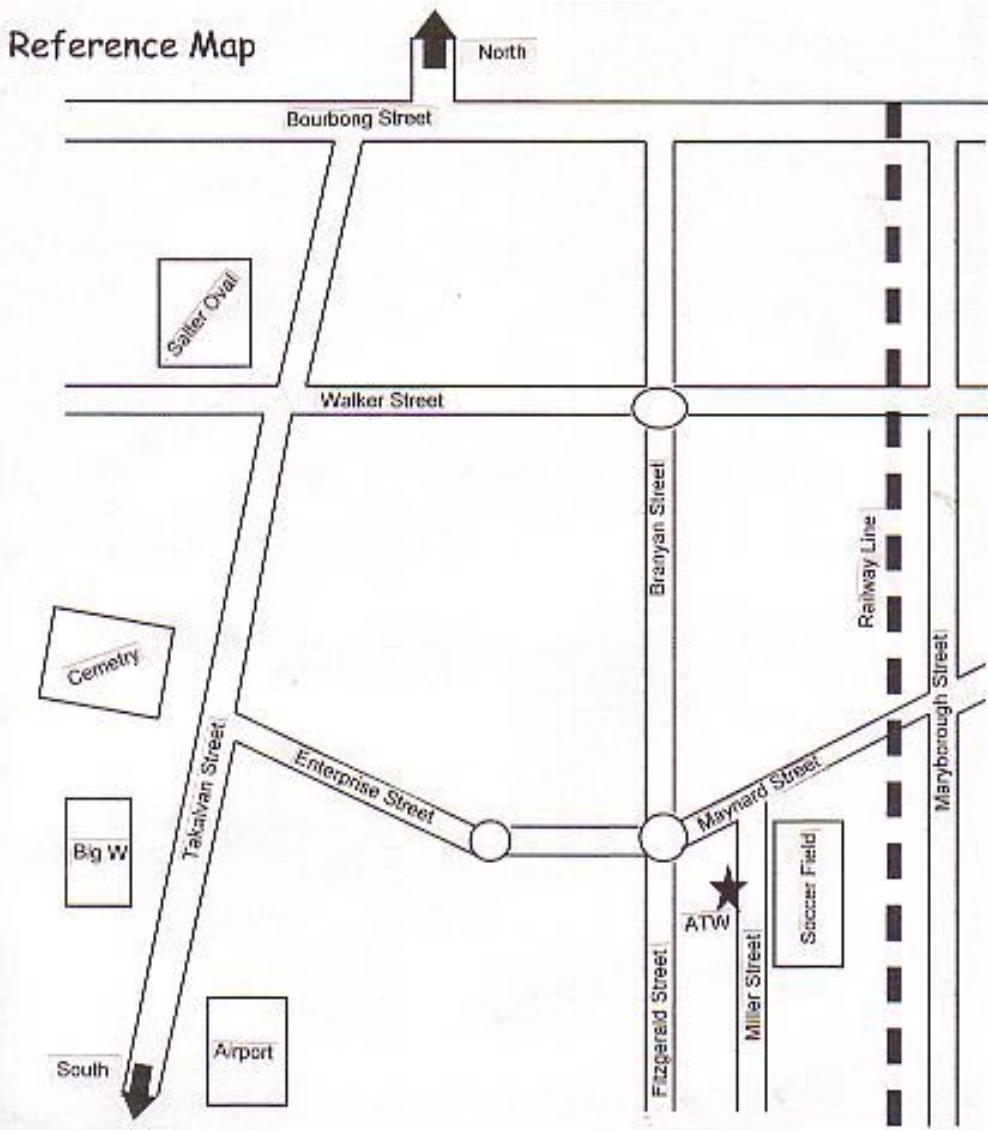

Important Information

Juniors – Under 15 years: Recite or read favourite verse

Novice Category: Anyone who has not been placed 1st in a Novice Competition. Competitors are eligible to compete in Intermediate Category but **not** in Open Category. Competitors may read their poems but this may disadvantage them slightly in adjudication.

Intermediate Category: Anyone who has not been placed 1st in any Intermediate Competition or 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Open Competition. Competitors are eligible to compete in Open Category. Competitors in the Intermediate Category **cannot** read their poems.

Open Category: Competitors **cannot** read their poems in this category.

Duo Category: A two-voiced poem with shared input. One poet must perform at least 25% of poem. Poets can only participate in one duo.

Overall Champion Poet: The Overall Champion Poet will be a poet from the Open Section (categories 7, 8 & 9 only) with the highest aggregate points. The joint decision of the judging panel is final. No discussion will be entered into.

Programme Timetable: Please state whether you will be available to perform on the Friday or Saturday or both days to enable programming to run smoothly.

Closing Date: Closing date for performance competition entries is June 20th, 2008 but late entries will be accepted on the week-end.

The Bundy Bush Poetry Muster will be conducted as near as possible to the guidelines of the ABPA.

Set out below is an extract of the Assessment Sheet that the judges will be using when judging your poetry performances.

PREAMBLE

Does the introduction help the audience to appreciate and enjoy the performance? (Your preamble is included in the **8 minute** time limit.)

START OF POEM

Did the performer immediately interest you, give a favourable impression, have good stance and good body language?

BODY OF POEM

Did the performer hold your attention, treat the poem intelligently, have good microphone technique or was it monotonous?

CONCLUSION

Did the performer build to a climax? Was the ending appropriate and satisfying?

AUDIBILITY

Was the performer loud enough, or too loud – was he/she easily understood, or hard to hear and understand?

MEMORIZATION

How well did the performer memorize the poem?

IMPACT

Did the poem suit the performer and have an impact?
