Conditions of Entry are as follows:

- All entries are to be received by Monday 11th October 2010
- Entry Fees must accompany the Entry Form.
- Entries will be restricted to the first 10 entries received for each Bush Poetry Competition.
- Entries will be restricted to one entry per participant per category. However in the event that ten nominations have not been received, multiple nominations may be accepted from an individual entrant.
- Entries will be confirmed by Wednesday 12th October 2010
- All performances will be restricted to a maximum of six minutes, including the preamble. Points will be deducted for presentations exceeding that time limit.
- Three Judges will preside over the evaluation of the performances.
- Judging sheets will be used for each Poetry Performance.
- A scrutineer will collate, record and check scores as determined from the judging sheets.
- A Timekeeper will accurately keep time of all contestants.
- The Judges decisions will be final and without further discussion.
- The organisers assume no responsibility for any claims of copyright infringement

Original Works (Category 1.)

- The Australian Poetry is to be written by the performer.
- Copyright of original works remains with the author, but organisers of the event reserve the right to publish the results.

Classical (Traditional) Works (Category 2.)

Entrants are to nominate preferentially two poems, and a first-in-first-served policy will be applied.

Primary School Works (Category 3.)

- Entrants are to be residents of the Uralla Shire.
- Entrants are to be enrolled in a Primary School.
- Entrants may read or recite their chosen poem.
- The Poetry Performance may be either 'your own work', or 'other poet's work'.

High School Works (Category 4.)

- Entrants are to be residents of the Uralla Shire.
- Entrants are to be enrolled in a School and be of high school age.
- Entrants may read or recite their chosen poem.
- The Poetry Performance may be either 'your own work', or 'other poet's work'.

Adult Novice Works (Category 5.)

- Entrants are not to have won a Bush Poetry Competition.
- Entrants are not restricted to being residents of the Uralla Shire.
- Entrants are to be not enrolled in a High School.
- The Poetry Performance may be either 'your own work', or 'other poet's work'.
- A Novice may compete in Category 1. and/or Category 2.
