4. Conditions of entry

Confirmation of entry fee is to accompany this form and returned to the organiser (David Stanley) for competitors to be eligible.

Entry fee \$20 or 15 for Open (Adults) (\$15 is for ABPA Members) \$15 for Novices (Adults) (\$10 is for ABPA Members) for each poem submitted, and **Free** for juniors.

Pay by direct deposit to APBA as above.

No refunds if disqualified.

The ABPA performance scoring rubric will be used in the competition.

Competitors have an 8-minute time allocation to introduce their poem (preamble) and perform the poem. Points will be deducted for going over time.

Performances are/will be judged on: Preamble / Physical presence / Dramatic appropriateness / memorisation / The poem and its interpretation / Voice and articulation and Entertainment value. Poems should also have an Australian theme or focus.

Entrants declare that they are the sole author of their poem or else, acknowledge the author in relevant sections.

Novice (Adult) and Junor (Children) entrants are required to perform one poem they or another poet have written. They do not have to perform an original poem.

Poems that have won 1st or 2nd place in any previous competitions should not be repeated by the same poet in this competition.

Poems can be read in any class, but marks will be deducted in the adult class for poems not memorised (as noted on the score / rubric sheet).

Entry into the Novice class is open to anyone who has **not** won a previous 1st or 2nd place in any competition within the past two years.

Content or themes that may be considered offensive, racist or sexist are strongly discouraged. If a poet is unsure about their theme or content they should discuss their concerns with the organiser prior to the competition.

CLOSING DATE for entries: 1st November, 2025

The judge's decisions are final, and discussions will not be entered into. It is anticipated that there will be three judges. They are The Rhymer from Ryde and Mel and Susie.
